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#### **Overview:**

We are seeking an energetic, motivated **midday supervisor and cleaner** with high standards to join our busy, friendly school. This is a permanent role, working Monday – Friday, 11:15am – 2:45pm, term time only. The salary for the role is BPS1A/5 £18,329, pro-rata.

#### **About us:**

We are a small infant school for children from Reception to Year 2. Our school is set in beautiful surroundings which complement and nurture every child's learning. In addition, we have two main classrooms that support a child initiated learning environment. We are passionate about the first formal years of school, and our teaching and learning reflect this.

#### **About the midday supervisor role:**

As our Midday Supervisor you will support our children whilst they eat their school meals in the village hall. Ensuring that they have a safe, happy and healthy lunchtime experience. All our meals are prepared fresh by our Hub kitchen and transported to us daily.

- Prepare the village hall for lunches and tidy afterwards.
- Serve hot meals and support the children throughout lunchtime.
- Promote healthy eating and lifestyles.
- Oversee outside play.
- Provide first aid.

#### **About the cleaning role:**

As our cleaner you will be responsible for ensuring our school is clean and welcoming for our staff, pupils and visitors.

- Ensure a high level of cleanliness is maintained throughout the school on a daily basis.
- Clean our classrooms, hallways, offices, staffroom/library, kitchen and washrooms.
- Have a good understanding of cleaning chemicals and equipment and health and safety.

#### **About you:**

If you enjoy working with children, have a positive attitude, a caring patient nature and are committed to helping our children feel happy and safe, please apply.

Previous experience is not necessary, but it is essential that you are able to work on your own initiative, with discretion and be flexible. We will provide training in all aspects of the job including health and safety, food hygiene, first aid, child protection and encouraging positive behaviour. The successful candidate will be required to provide references and have an enhanced DBS check. Thornborough Infant School is an equal opportunities employer.

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**Safeguarding:**
